In order to comply with town ordinances and to keep our parade safe, the following rules must be followed.

A FLOAT/ORGANIZATION APPLICATION MUST BE TURNED INTO FREDERICK HIGH SCHOOL BY FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 14th.

In past years, we have had students joining floats that have not turned in the proper permission forms. To help with this, we are instituting a new permission slip and parade check in policy and procedure.

*All participants will turn in their signed permission forms to the organization's team adult sponsor. Adult sponsors are encouraged to set deadlines to accept the forms. On the day of the parade, the adult sponsors will check in at staging area check in table, located at the Centennial Park parking lot. At that time, all collected permission slips will be given to the parade committee representative. Each sponsor will receive the appropriate amount of wrist tags to give to students and other participants. Only participants with a wrist band will be allowed to participate on a float or walking in the parade.

-Floats and organizations must be in compliance with ALL Risk Management Rules.

Failure to comply will result in removal from the Parade.
