



Greetings, future Warriors!

All of us at Frederick High School are excited to begin the registration process for your 8th grade student, and we're looking forward to a smooth transition from middle school to FHS. This letter includes general information about the process as well as some important dates.

On Monday and Tuesday of next week (February 6th and 7th), the Frederick High counseling team will visit Coal Ridge Middle School, Thunder Valley K8, Imagine Charter School and Carbon Valley Academy. The purpose is to explain our registration process and review course offerings available at FHS. Students will learn about programming in general, as well as core courses and electives that are available to ninth graders. Please keep your eyes open for registration materials coming home, and please touch base with your student as to potential course selections for next year. All 8th grade students and parents are invited and highly encouraged to attend our Registration Night event on Wednesday, February 8th at 6:00 pm in the Frederick High School Auditorium. Students are asked to bring their district iPads with them, as students will be entering course requests into Infinite Campus. At this event we will provide follow-up information from the middle school visits, present an overview of featured highlights including [CU Succeed](#) and our [Project Lead the Way Bio Medical program](#), as well as answer questions related to registration and high school in general. As mentioned, students will also enter next year's course requests.

We welcome parents who are choosing to open enroll at Frederick High! If you live outside of [our attendance area](#) and wish to attend FHS, it is helpful if the [Open Enrollment paperwork](#) is done in advance. This will ensure direct Infinite Campus access in signing up and registering for next year's courses. Students that wish to open enroll but haven't, will be able to do so during the registration night, but they won't be able to register for classes that evening.

Our staff will work closely with students, parents, and middle school teachers on appropriate math placements for next year. Students interested in our Honors program should select Honors courses during this process, and we will cross reference requests with available data and teacher recommendations to ensure appropriate placements.
