

Registration for the 2017 PSAT/NMSQT exam to be administered on Wednesday, October 11, 2017

Registration Deadline: Thursday, October 5th

1. Registration & Fees

Students must register for the 2017 PSAT/NMSQT exam between September 7th, 2017 and October 5th, 2017. No late registration will be accepted. The exam will be administered at Frederick High School on Wednesday, October 11th, 2017. Students must report to the small gym no later than 7:20 am. The cost for each exam is \$20.00.

Once you have completed registration, stop by the Counseling Office to pick up a practice exam booklet.

2. Why take the PSAT/NMSQT exam?

11th Grade students are encouraged to take the PSAT/NMSQT (known as PSAT) as a first step toward college admissions testing. This gives students and parents an idea of areas of academic strength and areas to practice, relative to what is tested on the SAT. The PSAT/NMSQT is one of the very first steps in opening up communications with specific schools.

- 1) The results gives the most up-to-date picture of where you are likely to score on the actual SAT. This will assist you in determining where you wish to spend your time and effort in preparing for the SAT exam.
- 2) As a junior, you are entered as a part of the National Merit Scholar Qualifying Test (NMSQT), a competition that awards some top scoring students across the nation with scholarships.
- 3) Another chance at a practice exam is always a good idea. This will help you to get a feel for the actual exam, which helps to reduce testing anxiety.

3. When are scores released?

PSAT/NMSQT results are usually sent to schools in late December and then are released to students online soon after. We will have an after school meeting to go over your result after the exam results are released.

4. What do I need to bring to the exam?

On testing day students need to bring a working calculator with fresh batteries, at least two Number 2 pencils and a great attitude!

5. How do I submit my exam fees?

After you register, you can pay for your exam fee via RevTrak or stop by the counseling office with a check or cash.

We only have 120 exams available, so make sure you register soon!
