



Dear Eighth Grade Students and Parents,

The staff at Frederick High School is excited to begin the registration process for next year's ninth grade students, and we are looking forward to a smooth transition from middle school to FHS. This letter includes general information about the process, as well as important dates. While [Open Enrollment](#) has not yet been finalized, we wanted to share this information without delay. Students who have completed the open enrollment paperwork should expect to hear from their school by January 17<sup>th</sup>.

Starting later this week, and continuing through next Tuesday the 15<sup>th</sup>, the Frederick High counseling team will visit Coal Ridge Middle School, Thunder Valley K8, Imagine Charter School and Carbon Valley Academy. The purpose of these visits is to explain our registration process and review course offerings available at FHS. Students will learn about programming in general, as well as core courses and electives that are available to ninth graders. Please keep your eyes open for registration materials coming home, and also touch base with your child as to potential course selections for next year. Students are asked to bring their district iPads with them, as they will be entering course requests into Infinite Campus that evening.** At this event we will provide follow-up information from the middle school visits, and share detailed information about school programming including 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Honors, Advanced Placement, CU Succeed, FHS Biomedical, and our brand new P-TECH (Pathways through Technology) program. The application processes to these programs will be discussed, and we will answer general questions about registration and the high school experience. Following the information session, students will use their iPads to enter next year's course requests.
